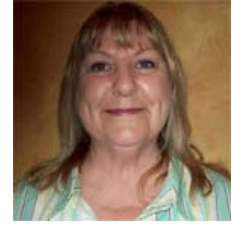

**Renaissance Festival update****Sept. 12 & 13, 2009****Holly, Michigan**

Hear ye! Hear ye! Thou art invited to partake in a most fabulous time while serving beer and wine at the Michigan Renaissance Festival in Holly, Michigan. For the past twenty-nine years (with the exception of one year that I am aware of), the Michigan JCI Senate has been in charge of the eleven beer and wine booths throughout the Michigan Renaissance Festival Village as a major fundraiser for our operating budget. Our weekend this year is Sept. 12 & 13. This particular weekend will be “Wonders of the World” and will include a Middle Eastern Dance Competition, a World Market, and a Bocce Ball Competition. **In the Special Activities Area (created last year) we will also be working a beer or wine tasting tent during all the hours that the festival is open. This is different from last year’s eight separate tents and is more similar to the past years’ large white tent in the middle of the village. We are asked to have seven workers at this tent, but this area may be scheduled in shifts.**

The hours of serving are from 10 a.m. – 7 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 12 and from noon – 7 p.m. on Sunday, Sept. 13. We ask that you volunteer for one or both complete days. The more people who volunteer, the more time each person has to enjoy the festival during break times. Depending on the type and location of the booth, three to five workers are usually needed at a time. **We are giving first pick of taverns/ booths to those who volunteer to spend time helping with the beer or wine tasting tent.** We would also love to hear from some people who would be willing to work the beer or wine tasting tent exclusively. It makes it easier on scheduling workers.

As volunteers for the Michigan JCI Senate, we will receive parking passes and free admission into the festival for the day in which we are working. Plus, while working, any tips received can be kept or donated by the worker. Any amount in the Tip Jars (which are placed on the counters) is equally shared by the workers of that booth before breaks are taken or donated to a cause to which the workers have agreed upon. Some senators expressed an interest in donating their tips to the campaign expenses of some US JCI Senate Officers. Each individual worker can make that decision. We will plan on having a tip jar at the beer or wine tasting tent and see how that works out this year.

The Senate, in the past, has enforced the rule that all workers must be at least 21 years old. Michigan Law does allow anyone at least 18 to serve alcohol. If anyone 18-20 volunteers to work for the Senate, they must have their ID with them at all times and will be scheduled to work the beer or wine tasting tent which has more supervision. At **NO TIME** can any worker consume alcohol before or while working. This includes while on a break (State Law). Our liquor license could be pulled from us if we are in violation of these rules. Also, following the Michigan Renaissance Festival Board’s rules, all workers throughout the village should be in garb (costume). The Senate has some costumes. When you sign up, let us know if you are in need of some costuming. In the past, on the average, each senator has brought around two to three family members and friends to help out. We need around 50-60 people a day so things run smoothly.

A block of ten hotel rooms at the Comfort Inn on Holly Rd., within a half mile off the expressway has been set aside for the Michigan JCI Senate **until August 11** for the evenings of Friday, Sept. 11 and Saturday, Sept. 12 at \$99 a night + tax. This hotel is only one exit northwest from the Renaissance Festival exit. When you call for reservations (1-800-694-0000), make sure you use the Group Code “Michigan JCI Senate”. You need to use your credit card to make your reservation. We have received notice that the US JCI Senate President will be joining us this year.

### **Step 1: Application with JCI.**

Each senatorship requires an application form supplied by US JCI to be filled out and signed by the chapter and state presidents. You will need to enclose a \$300 check payable to Junior Chamber International for full Senate membership payment, and a \$75 check payable to The U.S. Junior Chamber for Senate application processing.

*Allow 6-8 weeks for processing.*

Once JCI has issued a senatorship, you need to choose a state to be affiliated with such as the MI JCI Senate. Annual dues in Michigan are \$25 and includes your Senator badge. (**NOTE: Completing only Step 1 will get you a certificate of Senatorship, but NOT a badge.**) You will need to use the above form to register when submitting your dues. If you wish, you can also pay a one-time-fee of **\$200** which provides the Senator with a **life time membership with Michigan.**
