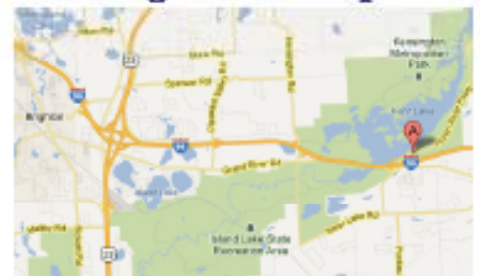

**MICHIGAN J.C.I. SENATE  
BY-LAWS  
Approved, ~~February 11, 2012~~ **October 5, 2013****

**ARTICLE II. DUES**

~~**Section 2.** Members whose dues are in arrears for a period of thirty (30) days of their Anniversary Date shall be suspended from membership on the thirty-first (31) day. Notice of delinquency will be sent to the member whose dues are in arrears thirty (30) days after the due date.~~

**Section 32.** **Members will be suspended if dues are not paid by invoice due date.** Members suspended for non-payment of dues may be reinstated by payment of current dues.

**Section 43.** Paid up Life Membership.

C. A Life Member ~~will~~ **is entitled** to receive all issues of the "Filibuster".

D. A Life Member ~~will~~ **is entitled** to receive all issues of "Mentors Magazine".

**ARTICLE III. GOVERNMENT**

**Section 1.** The government of this organization shall be vested in a Board of Directors comprised of a President, Chairman of the Board, two (2) Vice Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer, ~~Area Coordinators~~ and appointed Legal Counsel, who are subject to the will of the membership.

~~**Section 2.** There shall be one Area Coordinator elected from each area. The Board of Directors shall determine areas at the beginning of each year.~~

~~**Section 32.** The Board of Directors shall have the control and management of the property of the organization subject to the will of the membership. Funds of the organization can only be withdrawn from the bank with which they are on deposit by the **two (2) signatures of which one must be** the Treasurer ~~or President~~. All disbursements from organization funds shall be by check only, and with prior approval of the Board of Directors.~~

**ARTICLE IV. ELECTIONS**

**Section 2.** No member of the Nominating Committee shall be eligible for nomination for any office ~~by action of the Nominating Committee.~~



**Section 3.** Sixty (60) days prior to the annual meeting, the Nominating Committee will submit to the Secretary in writing, the names of candidates for election. ~~The membership shall be provided with, in writing and at least thirty (30) days prior to the annual meeting, a list of all candidates.~~

**See Article V Meetings, Section 3.**

**Section 6.** At the annual election, there will be elected a President, two (2) Vice Presidents, a Secretary, and a Treasurer, all of whom will constitute the Officers of this organization, and will serve for one (1) year terms. ~~To complete the Board of Directors, there shall be elected Area Coordinators. Area Coordinators shall be elected for a one (1) year term.~~

**Section 10.** Qualifications for election to office:

A. President – Must be member in good standing of the Michigan J.C.I. Senate and must have served at least one year as an officer ~~or Area Coordinator~~ prior to seeking this office.

**ARTICLE V. MEETINGS**

**Section 1.** Annual Meeting: The annual election meeting of this organization shall be held **no sooner than 30 days to but no more than 90 days prior to the end of the calendar year** ~~on a Saturday no more than thirty (30) days prior to the U.S.J.C.I. Senate Region V Spring Meeting. If Michigan is hosting the Spring Region Meeting the Annual meeting and elections may be held on the Saturday of the Spring Region Meeting.~~ The current Board of Directors shall determine the exact date and location of the meeting. **This meeting will be noticed out to each member either electronically or postmarked to their last known mailing address at least thirty (30) days prior to the meeting.** ~~Notice of this meeting will be mailed to members at their last known address at least thirty (30) days prior to the election.~~

**Section 2.** Regular Meetings: The regular meetings of this organization will be held on the same weekend as the Michigan Jaycees **Conference / Convention in addition to the Annual Meeting.** ~~hold their State Board of Directors meetings. In addition, the April meeting of the Michigan J.C.I. Senate shall be a regular meeting.~~

**ARTICLE VIII: REGIONAL COORDINATORS**

**Section 1:** ~~Region Coordinators shall be appointed by the President with approval of the appropriate Area Coordinator and Vice President and shall serve a one (1) year term.~~

**Section 2:** ~~Region Coordinators will be ex-officio members of the Board of Directors and will be charged with the responsibility of furthering the goals and activities, public relations, and Senator participation in the Michigan J.C.I. Senate.~~

**Section 3:** ~~Region Coordinators shall be responsible to the Area Coordinator.~~

**ARTICLE ~~IX~~VIII. RULES OF ORDER**

**ARTICLE ~~XIX~~. DELEGATIONS**

**Section 1.** Delegations consisting of not more than two (2) officers starting with the President and one other in descending order shall represent the vote and/or will of the organization at National and International conventions. **If no officers are in attendance, no more than two (2) representatives shall be appointed by the President.** Such delegates shall exercise only those powers vested in them by the Board of Directors. Their registration fees ~~shall~~ **may** be paid from the organization's funds subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.
